

MAY 26th WADDESDON MANOR - £25pp (incl. entrance) National Trust members £15pp (coach only)

Following the 2011 Christmas lights trip, due to popular demand; a visit to this renaissance style chateau, built by the Rothschild's and still home to decorative arts and furniture from the 18th Century. The Victorian garden is considered one of the finest in England with fountains, statuary and an aviary at its heart.

MAY 31st NESS BOTANICAL GARDENS - £20pp (incl. entrance)

Overlooking the Dee Estuary, these gardens contain reputedly the finest collection of rhododendrons and azaleas; best known heather gardens; outstanding collection of Himalayan & Chinese plants; rose, herb and rock gardens; waterfall and ever-popular water gardens, something for everyone!

JUNE 2nd COVENTRY TRANSPORT MUSEUM - £15pp (coach only)

At the heart of the birthplace of the British cycle and motor industry, Coventry Transport Museum displays the worlds largest collection of British road transport. This is no ordinary museum though admission is FREE!

JUNE 13th MYSTERY TOUR PM - £8pp (coach only)

JUNE 16th - OXFORD DAY - £15pp (coach only)

Explore the architecture and heritage of this amazing city by foot or boat along the Thames, visiting the Christ Church Cathedral, libraries and museums.

JUNE 23rd ALBERT DOCKS LIVERPOOL - £20pp (incl. ferry)

Enjoy the short trip on the ferry across the Mersey, to visit the award-winning attractions, including galleries, museums and shops, at the Albert Docks. Alternatively, a short walk or bus can take you to visit the centre of Liverpool.

JUNE 30th ST ALBANS DAY - £15pp (coach only)

Hertfordshire's oldest town - has risen from an Iron Age settlement into a vibrant modern city over the course of 2000 years of human occupation. With a huge street market and a wealth of remarkable heritage, there's plenty to see and do!

JULY 14th ALE TRAIL - £10pp (coach only)

JULY 21st WESTON SUPER MARE - £15pp (coach only)

A great seaside resort with miles of clean sandy beaches and a level promenade, boasting superb views over the Channel.

AUGUST 1st - PENYBONT TROTting RACES - £21pp (incl. entrance)

Trotting is a truly amateur sport. Most of the competitors own train and drive their own horses, and the races are usually 1 mile long, with the crowd never far away from the action. The magic of a day at the trotting races is something which has a uniquely Welsh feel to it.

AUGUST 16th MORGAN FACTORY - £23pp (incl. entrance & tour)

Take a guided tour of the famous Morgan Car factory and see the skilled craftsmen hand make the bespoke sports cars, coupling the traditional skills with cutting edge technology. Then visit the museum to experience the history of this unique British car.

AUGUST 18th SOUTHPORT DAY - £15pp (coach only)

Southport is bursting with loads to see & do, with an array of attractions, parks and gardens, miles of golden sand and beautiful natural coastline.

AUGUST 23rd KING ARTHUR & TALYLLYN - £22pp (incl. steam train)

King Arthur's Labyrinth and the Corris Craft Centre, for lunch, shopping or exploration, before experiencing the joy of Duncan Day on the Talylyn railway into Tywyn Wharf, to browse the Narrow Gauge Railway Museum.

AUGUST 25th BLACK COUNTRY MUSEUM - £23pp/£19 conc/£17 child (incl. entrance)

Historic buildings from all around the Black Country have been moved and authentically rebuilt, to create a tribute to the traditional skills and enterprise of the people that once lived in the heart of industrial Britain.

AUGUST 25th DUDLEY ZOO - £21pp/£19 conc/£17 child (incl. entrance)

The zoo is home to more than 1300 animals, with 168 species, including the awesome Meerkat's. At its heart are the ruins of an 11th century castle and the world's largest single collection of Tectons offer a glimpse of times past.

AUGUST 28th LLANGOLLEN & HORSE DRAWN CRUISE - £20pp (incl. cruise)

Step back in time for an unforgettable journey by horse drawn barge, enjoying the peace and tranquillity of the Llangollen Canal, before spending the afternoon in this encapsulating little town, so popular with visitors to Wales.

SEPT 11th - ANDERTON BOAT LIFT - £20pp (incl. entrance/lift/boat)

Whether you're an engineering enthusiast or history fanatic, this magnificently restored boat lift will not fail to amaze. Take a trip on the lift, coupled with a cruise along the Weaver Navigation and a visit to the exhibition and grounds.

SEPT 18th WELSH LAKES & STEAM TRAIN TOUR - £20pp (incl. train)

Scenic tour through the heartland of Wales, with a stop at the picturesque lake Vernwy, before a steam train ride along lake Bala and into its bustling shoreline town for lunch.

SEPT 25th JODRELL BANK & HACK GREEN SECRET BUNKER - £25pp (incl. entrances)

Visit the home of the internationally renowned and awe inspiring, giant Lovell Telescope coupled with a Space & Planet Pavilion answering many of those unanswered questions! Then on to one of the nations most secret defence sites, Hack Green, which played a central role in the defence of Britain for almost sixty years and was only closed in 1966.

SEPT 29th TEWKESBURY - £15pp (coach only)

Renowned as having one of the best medieval black and white townscapes in the country, Tewkesbury is a thriving market town that is a pure delight to behold and a must for all visitors to the Cotswolds.

OCT 4th RACE DAY - BANGOR ON DEE - £25pp (incl. entrance to races)

Enjoy a day out at the races with course tickets & then stop on the return at a pub for dinner or just a drink (not included).

OCT 9th PM HOBSONS BREWERY TOUR - £12pp (incl. tour)

Tour Shropshire's premier sustainable brewer, and creator of award winning beers. Established in 1993 Hobson's is a leading producer and committed to supporting the area, its people and resources.

OCT 17th LITTLE MORETON HALL - £20pp (inc entrance) National Trust members £15pp (coach only)

One of the National Trusts most iconic properties, and one of the finest examples of a timber-framed moated building in England. It is truly miraculous that the bizarre architectural charm of its three storeys, with bulging walls is still standing, having commenced being built in the 1450s.

OCT 28th BLACKPOOL ILLUMINATIONS - £15pp (£11 child) (coach only)

Enjoy the afternoon in Blackpool, before relaxing in the coach for the drive through the promenades famous illuminations.

NOV 4th ALTON TOWERS - £15pp (£10 child) - (coach only)

Enjoy a day with the fun of the theme park, before experiencing the huge firework extravaganza in front of the castle, riveting for both children & adults.

NOV 10th - NORTH PEMBERTON GUY FAWKES CARNIVAL - £15pp/£10 child (coach only)

Rio de Janeiro is brought to Somerset, England. With all the fun & uniqueness, this illuminated carnival will mesmerise you with its creativity and illumination. An experience not to be missed!

NOV 15th CHRISTMAS at ABBEY CWM HIR - £25pp (incl. tour)

Enjoy the informative tour around this breathtaking 52 room Gothic Mansion, with stunning interiors and fascinating collections. See the magical, unique 52 Xmas tree extravaganza and don't forget the slippers to complete this remarkable memorable experience.
